## 2. *How to start* THE ENGINE



### PREVENTING 99% ENGINE PROBLEMS

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY AND YOUR ENGINE WILL STAY  
HAPPIER THAN YOU ARE.

1. SET THE THROTTLE TO "START," WAIT 5 SECONDS, THEN  
SHIFT GEARS GENTLY. TREAT IT LIKE A SHY ANIMAL—BE  
CALM AND YOU'LL HARVEST THE GOOD TIMES, NOT THE  
BAD ONES.
2. PULL STARTING CORD AND IF IT GIVES IN, THE ENGINE IS  
IN NEUTRAL AND GOOD TO START.
3. THIS IS THE PLACE WHERE MOST PEOPLE HEROICALLY (AND  
ACCIDENTALLY) SNAP THE STARTING CABLE. DON'T JOIN  
THE HALL OF FAME. JUST KEEP THE ENGINE RUNNING.

# 3. FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE RULES AND WE'LL ALL HAVE A DRAMA-FREE DAY ON THE WATER

- Sail sloooowly in villages — max 2 mph / 3 km/h. Even ducks will appreciate it.
- Please don't use the land as a toilet. Farmers stay happy, cows stay healthy, and everyone's shoes stay clean. Big win.
- Stick to the right side of the canal. It's like driving... but wetter.
